It honors an individual or family with a proven record of exceptional generosity who, through direct financial support, demonstrates outstanding civic and charitable responsibility and whose generosity encourages others to take philanthropic leadership roles on a community, national or international level.

Nominations will be considered on the basis of the following criteria:

- Description of participation in, and gift support of, nonprofit organizations in the community, nationally and/or internationally. (0-65 points)
- Description of philanthropic support of innovative approaches to solving problems. (0-10 points)
- Evidence of motivation given to others to take leadership roles in philanthropy (i.e. challenge gifts, matching gifts, volunteering). (0-25 points)

Award for Outstanding Volunteer Fundraiser

This award is presented jointly by the AFP Connecticut and AFP Fairfield County Chapters. It honors an individual or family who demonstrates outstanding skills in coordinating and motivating groups of volunteers for fundraising projects for the benefit of charitable institutions.

The recipient must have demonstrated leadership skills in coordinating groups of volunteers for major fundraising projects for more than one nonprofit organization. Nominations will be considered based on the responses to the following criteria:

- Evidence of quality of leadership and organizational ability in fundraising campaigns. (0-25 points)
- Description of time, effort and personal financial commitment. (0-25 points)
- Description of fundraising goals achieved by his/her effort. (0-15 points)
- Evidence of success in recruiting and motivating others. (0-20 points)
- Description of participation in other local, national and/or international nonprofit organizations. (0-15 points)

- Description of impact of gift support and achievements accomplished through the foundation's efforts. (0–35 points)
- Evidence of motivation given to others to take leadership roles toward philanthropy and community involvement. (0–20 points)

Award for Outstanding Youth in Philanthropy

This award is presented jointly by the AFP Connecticut and AFP Fairfield County Chapters. It recognizes service by an individual or group of young people (ages 5 to 17) who demonstrate outstanding commitment to the community through direct financial support, development of charitable programs, volunteering and leadership in philanthropy.

Nominations will be considered based on the following criteria:

- Description in detail of what the nominee did, including goals, process, budget (if relevant) and other people involved in the process (adult leaders, advisors, etc.), and of the time, talent and/or treasure the youth gave for the common good and the results that were achieved. (0-40 points)
- Description of the impact the nominee had on the community, including numbers of people involved, financial impact, organizations helped, etc. Please include the names and contact information of individuals at the organizations who benefited from the nominee's work. (0-30 points)
- Long term (1-2 years) impact of the nominee's work. Will the project(s) be ongoing and has the nominee considered next steps or is working on other projects? (0-20 points)
- Evidence that the project(s) can serve as a prototype for others or is easily replicable in other communities. (0-10 points)

Award for Outstanding Fundraising Professional

This award is presented jointly by the AFP Connecticut and AFP Fairfield County Chapters. It honors an outstanding fundraising professional who works full-time for a nonprofit, charitable organization, practices his/her profession in an exemplary manner, and is a member of AFP Connecticut or AFP Fairfield County. CFRE or ACFRE certification is not required.

Nominations will be considered based on responses to the following criteria:

- Brief description of career achievements, length and tenure of fundraising background, experience and results. The recipient must have at least 10 years of professional fundraising experience. (0–25 points).
- Evidence of quality of leadership that is effective, creative and stimulating, and that the individual acts as a team player. (0–20 points)
- Membership in AFP and evidence that the individual practices and promotes the AFP *Code of Ethical Principles and Standards* for fundraising professionals found at www.afpnet.org. To determine if someone you wish to nominate is an AFP member, contact David Crandall at 203–254–2044. (0–20 points)
- Brief description of individual's commitment to continuing professional development, including certification (CFRE or ACFRE certification is not required), conference participation, publication and professional education. (0–15 points)
- Evidence of commitment to fundraising and philanthropy through voluntary service and financial support of nonprofit organizations. (0–20 points)

The Barbara Marion Award for Outstanding Leadership to AFP

This award recognizes an AFP member who demonstrates outstanding leadership and service to the association and/or its related entities, such as the AFP Foundation for Philanthropy.

The nominee must be a current AFP member in any category and must have been an AFP member for a minimum of 15 years (based on the date nominations are due). Eligible nominees will be considered for the award based on the responses to the following:

- Evidence and description in detail of leadership the nominee has provided to build, advance and promote AFP:
 - Primary Criteria: Activities and leadership on the regional, national and international levels
 - Secondary Criteria: Activities and leadership on the chapter level
- Evidence and description in detail of the nominee’s involvement in training, teaching and/or mentoring and the creation or development of programs, campaigns, initiatives and projects that help advance and improve AFP and its members (e.g. membership, continuing education, certification, ethics, government relations, public relations).
- Evidence and description in detail of how the nominee encourages others to take leadership roles while also serving as a team player and as a role model for others in practicing core values of the association (e.g., promotes the *AFP Code of Ethical Principals and Standards of Professional Practice*, achieves certification, evidences commitment to continuing education).
- Evidence and description in detail of the nominee’s voluntary service and financial support to AFP, the AFP Foundation for Philanthropy and/or other appropriate bodies.
