



## Award for Outstanding Philanthropist

This award is presented jointly by the AFP Connecticut and AFP Fairfield County Chapters. It honors an individual or family with a proven record of exceptional generosity who, through direct financial support, demonstrates outstanding civic and charitable responsibility and whose generosity encourages others to take philanthropic leadership roles on a community, national or international level. Nominations will be considered on the basis of the following criteria:

1. Description of participation in and gift support of nonprofit organizations in the community, nationally and/or internationally. (0-65 points)
2. Description of philanthropic support of innovative approaches to solving problems. (0-10 points)
3. Evidence of encouragement and motivation given to others to take leadership roles in philanthropy (i.e. challenge gifts, matching gifts, volunteering, etc.). (0-25 points)

Philanthropists that received this award in the last three years are ineligible for consideration. Attach responses to the above criteria in a summary format of no more than three pages. **Each criteria should be numbered and addressed separately in narrative form. Deadline for submission is July 16, 2012.**
