



This award is presented jointly by the AFP Connecticut and AFP Fairfield County Chapters. It honors an individual or family that demonstrates outstanding skills in coordinating and motivating groups of volunteers for fundraising projects for the benefit of charitable institutions. The recipient must have demonstrated exceptional leadership skills in coordinating groups of volunteers for major fundraising projects for more than one nonprofit organization. Nominations will be considered based on the responses to the following criteria:

- Evidence of quality of leadership and organizational ability in fundraising campaigns. (0-25 points)
- Description of time, effort and personal financial commitment. (0-25 points)
- Description of fundraising goals achieved by his/her effort. (0-15 points)
- Evidence of success in recruiting and motivating others. (0-20 points)
- Description of participation in other local, national and/or international nonprofit organizations. (0-15 points)

Volunteer Fundraisers that received this award in the last three years are ineligible for consideration. Please attach responses to the above criteria in a summary format of no more than three pages. <u>Each criteria should be numbered and addressed separately in narrative form. Deadline for submission is July 16, 2102.</u>
