When Trustees successfully fulfill their responsibilities in raising funds, they ensure the present and future fiscal health of the organization. Conversely, when they resist their responsibilities for raising funds, they impede the organization's ability to compete philanthropically. During this session, you will explore your role and responsibilities, along with implementation strategies, to enable you to become an effective advocate, including as a fundraiser, for your organization.

At the conclusion of this session:


- Based on best practice benchmarks, participants will explore stages of board engagement

Directions to New Beginnings Family Academy

I-95 Southbound

Exit 27 off of 195 South. Stay straight (don't bear right onto Lafayette Blvd).

Then, stay to the right and go thru 2 traffic lights.

Take a right on Park Avenue and first left onto Garden Street.

School is at end of Garden Street.

Parking lot is on left, across street from school.

Push doorbell at front door and secretary will let you in.

I-95 Northbound

Exit 27 off of 195 North. Go straight through first light. At second light take left under highway.

At light take Left. Stay to the right - do not get back on highway.

Take right onto Park Avenue.

Take first left onto Garden Street.

School is at end of Garden Street.

Parking lot is on left, across street from school.

Push doorbell at front door and secretary will let you in.

Route 8

Route 8 South to Exit 1, Prospect Street

Take right at end of exit. Continue to end of road. (Park Ave.)

Take left onto Park.

Take right onto Garden Street. (Corner of old Park City Hospital and Mercy Learning Ctr.)

School is at end of Garden Street.

Parking lot is on left, across street from school.

Push doorbell at front door and secretary will let you in.
